




The history of the bicycle

The first bicycle was made of wood and had no pedals. You had to walk along and then lift your legs.






In 1865 a bicycle with pedals on the front wheels was invented. It had metal wheels.

In 1870 the 'penny-farthing' was invented. At the front it had a large wheel with pedals on it. At the back there was a small wheel. The bicycle was made of metal and had hard rubber tyres. It was very easy to fall off a penny-farthing.





Next came a bike that looked a lot like today's bicycles. But the tyres were still made of hard rubber. It was very uncomfortable to ride.

In the 1890s John Dunlop invented rubber tyres that were filled with air. After that, bicycle riding was much more comfortable.
